POLICY Members are permitted to bring alcohol into the pavilion area. However, Wyoga Lake Homeowners Association ("the Association") does not have liquor insurance. Therefore, it is understood that individuals hosting a gathering at the pavilion are responsible for the consumption of alcohol by his/her guests and will assume FULL responsibility for all alcohol related and influenced activities, including but not limited to damage to physical property and drunk driving liabilities. The Association recommends that members hosting events at the pavilion purchase special event liability insurance. No alcohol is to be sold on the premises and no alcohol is to be served to anyone under the age of 21. Glass is not permitted on the premises and all alcohol must be removed from the premises at the end of the event. All state and local liquor licenses must be followed.	
Members agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Association, its officers, directors, employees, agents and members present, past, and future from any and all charges, claims, costs, causes of action, damages and liabilities (including but not limited to, attorneys' fees) for any and all injuries to either person or property, which arise from or are in any way related to the above activity, or use of the pavilion. All members and guests are bound by the rules set forth in this provision.
